



Seattle Adaptive Sports Equipment Loaning Policy

SAS has limited equipment available on a first come, first served basis. There is a \$100 fee, per season, to rent a piece of sports equipment. The athlete is responsible for properly maintaining the equipment, including tires, wheels, blades, upholstery and repairs.

The policy for loaning equipment is:

- Athlete is an active participant, in good standing, in their respective SAS program.
- Equipment to be returned if not attending practices after 1 month (exception allowed for medical reasons, with intent to return to the program). Rental fee will not be returned.
- If available, athlete must compete at a hosted tournament, per year.
- Athlete is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the equipment during usage.
- Equipment must be returned in similar condition as at the check-out date.

If you are unable to fulfill the requirements of the team policy for loaning equipment, the equipment needs to be returned to the team immediately so that it is available for another athlete.
